From the 4th show-cause filed by Respondent No. 1 and on a perusal of Annexures A and B appended therewith read along with the cheques (Annexure-B/1 and B/2) and the statement (Annexure-B/3) it is seen that payment of compensation after deducting the Income Tax has been undertaken and the entire amount has been paid, even though after some delay and directions issued by this Court for which apology has also been tendered.

Accepting the same and finding no further indulgence to be made in the matter, the application is disposed of. In case the petitioners have any grievance with regard to the assessment made



and the amount of compensation paid, so also the action of deducting the Income Tax, liberty shall be available to the petitioners to challenge the same in accordance with law but now, in view of the compliance reported by the respondents, I am not inclined to proceed further in the contempt proceedings. Respondents are discharged from the proceedings and the application disposed of.
