Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that for the relief prayed in the present writ application, he has also moved before the respondent no. 4 on 07.07.2016. He submitted that till date the same has still not been disposed off.

3. Learned counsel for the State submitted that the same shall be disposed off expeditiously.
