5 24-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Patna Mahila P.S. Case No. 25 of 2016 registered under
Sections 376(D), 420, 468, 471/34 of the Indian Penal Code and
66 of I.T. Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the F.I.R. is lodged after four years of the alleged
occurrence. The petitioner, being owner of the restaurant, is quite
innocent and has not involved in this case in any way. In fact, the
informant had love affair with one Md. Naiz, waiter of his
restaurant, who is the main culprit of the alleged occurrence.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the J.M., 1st Class, Patna in connection with Patna Mahila P.S. Case No. 25 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
