Inter alia, contending that there are encroachment in
public road bearing khata No.358 plot No.912 which links village

Officer, Ratani Faridpur, District Jehanabad has not taken any action and has not removed the encroachment, this petition has been filed in public interest.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, it is directed that on the petitioner filing a certified copy of this order along with relevant documents, the Circle Officer concerned, Respondent No.6, shall look into the grievance of the petitioner, issue notice to the encroachers, hear them and after due process of law shall take such step for removal of encroachment, if any, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the application stands disposed of.
