Apart from the fact that there is an inordinate unexplained delay of more than 683 days on account of which this appeal is liable to be dismissed, we find that the appeal pertains to



recruitment to the process which was initiated by an advertisement No.1 of 2004 and the learned Writ Court refused to interfere into the controversy pertaining to recruitment that took place in the year 2004 and we see no reason in the facts and circumstances of the case to interfere into the matter. The appeal stands dismissed.
