ORAL ORDER

2 15-02-2017 Mr. Amish Kumar learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Jai Prabhat Kishore, A.C. to S.C.13 for the State, Mr. Amit Pandey for the Zila Parishad and Mr. Girijesh Kumar for the Magadh University.
