The petitioner is accused in connection with

Turkauliya (Banjariya) P.S. Case No. 430 of 2016 registered under

Sections 272, 273 and 353 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections

47, 51 and 54 of the Bihar Excise Amendment Act.

The accusation is of recovery of five literes of illicit

liquor in a plastic gallon, one and half litres of illicit liquor in a

plastic bottle put on the motorcycle and also two litres of illicit

liquor in the Dickey of motorcycle, at the house of petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since



26.10.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Turkauliya (Banjariya) P.S. Case No. 430 of 2016. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
