2 17-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Chapra
Town P.S. Case No. 214 of 2016 registered under Section 47 of
the Excise Act.

The accusation is that petitioner was apprehended by
the police in suspicious condition and on disclosure of the
petitioner, 81 litre country made liquor, in plastic Jarkins, was
recovered at the bank of river, near Sonar Patti, Nichli Road.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case mere on
suspicion. It is further submitted that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and is in custody since 09.05.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of



the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Chapra Town P.S. Case No. 214 of 2016. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
