Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offence under Sections 47 and 30 of Bihar Excise Act.

It has been submitted that country made liquor and foreign liquor were recovered from the tempo on which the petitioner along with the other accused Md. Danish Alam were sitting. The seizure list was prepared which does not bear the signature of the petitioner. The petitioner is said to be in custody since 8.10.2016. It is mentioned in paragraph-3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. IX, Patna, in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 149 of 2016, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.

The petitioner is directed to file an affidavit in the court below stating therein that he will not indulge in such type of activities in future otherwise, his bail bonds would be liable to be cancelled.
