2 01-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 412, 413/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Petitioner is in jail custody since 21.01.2016 on the
allegation that stolen idols were recovered from his house.

Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was
rejected by this court but submission on behalf of the petitioner is
that up till now, the trial of the petitioner has not commenced.

Considering the period of detention of the petitioner
in jail custody as well as this aspect of the matter that petitioner
does not have any criminal antecedent, let the petitioner be



released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 03 of 2016.
