The petitioner is accused in connection with Patori  
P.S. Case No. 345/2016, registered under Sections 304B/34 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing of the sister of the  
informant by her husband and in-laws due to non-fulfillment of  
demand of Pulsar Motorcycle.

Submission is that the petitioner is father-in-law of the  
deceased and he is in custody since 21.01.2017. Co-accused  
Pramod Pandit, husband of the deceased, is already in custody.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of  
the case, the petitioner, Raghunandan Pandit, above named, is



directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Patori P.S. Case No. 345/2016.
