ORAL ORDER

2 09-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel representing the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kahalgaon
(Ghogha) P.S. Case No. 262 of 2016 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 25(1-b)A, 26/35 of the Arms Act.

Allegedly, three persons were apprehended and from
possession of two co-accused arms and ammunitions were
recovered whereas from possession of the petitioner one live .315
bore cartridge was recovered.

Submission is of false implication and that the petitioner
is in custody since 07.08.2016 having no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP submits that considering the period of
detention now lenient view can be taken.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, the petitioner



above named is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Kahalgaon (Ghogha) P.S. Case No. 262 of 2016, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be a near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
