Be that as it may, as a matter of last indulgence, I direct the University to make entire payment within a period of four weeks from today from whatever sources the funds are available to the University, failing



which the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and Finance Officer would be liable to be proceeded in contempt.

With this direction and observation, this application stands disposed of.
