3 28-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 483 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 103 and 104 of Trademark Act, 1999 as well as Sections 63, 64 and 65 of Copyright Act, 1957.

There is allegation of violation of Trademark Act and Copyright Act by the petitioner to the extent that the petitioner was found selling honey of Dabur, though it was not made by Dabur.

Considering the nature of allegation, let petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount



each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VII, Darbhanga/Successor Court, in connection with Keoti P.S. Case No.6 of 2017, with condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the Court-below shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail-bonds of the petitioner in this case.
