Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Kotwali (Tilkamanjhi)

P.S. Case 646 of 2016 instituted for the offence under Sections
25(1-b)a and 26 of the Arms Act.

It has been submitted that petitioner is in custody
since 24.11.2016. He has no criminal antecedent.

In the written report, it is alleged that one loaded
country made pistol and one live cartridge have been recovered
from the possession of the petitioner. It is mentioned in paragraph-
3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In such circumstances, keeping in view the period
spent by the petitioner in custody and having clean antecedent,
prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above



named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with Kotwali (Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 646 of 2016, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.

The petitioner is directed to remain physically present in court on each and every date till disposal of the trial and any two subsequent defaults will result in cancellation of bail bonds in the court below.

It is made clear that in the event criminal antecedent has been found against the petitioner prior to grant of bail by this Court, the court below will be at liberty to take appropriate action for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
