Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with
Kumarkhand P.S.Case No. 233 of 2016 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 447, 323, 324, 354,
429, 435, 379 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and
he has remained in custody for about three months having clean
antecedent. It has further been submitted that there is case and
counter case between the parties.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the fact that
petitioner has remained in custody for about three months and
there is case and counter case between the parties, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura, in connection with Kumarkhand P.S.Case No. 233 of 2016, subject to the conditions that :-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
