3 09-11-2017 The Bank is directed to pay the leave encashment of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from today because there is no provision in any of the rules, which debars an employee, even though compulsorily retired, from claiming leave encashment, which is rightfully due to him. The issue of payment of gratuity or the interest thereon will be subject matter of the outcome of a writ application, which has been moved by the Bank in which notices have already been issued to the petitioner.

Writ application stands disposed off in terms of the above direction.
