Heard parties.

Petitioner claims to have been appointed as Panchayat Secretary in the District of Sheikhpura on 17.1.1997 and since then he is discharging the duties on the said post. His claim is that he should be given benefit of first ACP in pay band of Rs. 9300 – 34800/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/- after completion of 12 years on the post of Panchayat Secretary which should have been given on 17.11.2009 but that has not been granted.

Petitioner places reliance upon a decision dated 5.8.2016 of a coordinate Bench of this Court rendered in **C.W.J.C.**



No.9451 of 2013 (Brajesh Kumar Versus The State of Bihar & Ors.). It is jointly submitted at the Bar that this case is covered by the aforesaid decision and this case may also be disposed of in terms thereof.

Accordingly, this writ application also stands disposed of in terms thereof directing the respondent State to grant 1st ACP to the petitioner without unnecessary delay preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order.
