The petitioner seeks bail in Hajipur Sadar P.S. Case
No. 543/2015, registered for the offences punishable under
Section 302 and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that the petitioner came and
took her husband for settlement of land dispute, but the informant
and her mother-in-law speculating some untoward, followed her
husband and saw that Harendra Singh (petitioner) and his son
Sunil Singh were catching her husband and they ordered Arvind
Singh to kill, on such, Arvind Singh fired and her husband died on
the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is an old man. He has no manner of concern with the husband of the informant. The allegation is ornamental.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

It appears that it was the petitioner, who took the deceased to the place of occurrence for settlement of land dispute, but the petitioner caught the deceased and on his order, Arvind Singh fired, causing the death of the deceased on the spot.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above-named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after six months from today.
