Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence punishable under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The F.I.R. of motorcycle theft is against unknown.

Submission of the petitioner is that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner though the petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2016, however, has been falsely remanded in this case due to some other criminal cases lodged with the same police station, of the year 2016, relating to the offence of theft registered against unknown.
