Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Madhuban

P.S. Case No. 169 of 2016 registered under Sections- 341, 342,

343, 324, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no

occurrence as alleged ever took place, rather he has been made

victim of false implication due to oblique and ulterior motive.

There is no specific allegation against any of the accused

persons. Petitioner never demanded any dowry nor subjected

the informant to cruelty. Injury report does not support the

allegations. Petitioner is in custody since 16.08.2016.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the



case, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 4th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Madhuban P.S. Case No. 169 of 2016.
