counsel for the State.

This is an application for grant of regular bail to the petitioner who is accused in Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 242 of 2016 for offences under Sections 25(1-b)A, 26 of Arms Act.

It appears from the F.I.R. that country made revolver has been recovered from the waist of the petitioner.

In para-12 of the petition it is stated that the mother of the petitioner has filed a petition before the Senior Superintendent of Police on 05.12.2016, much before the date of occurrence, alleging demand of Rs. 25,000/- by the police.

Without going into the statement made in para 12 of the bail petition, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, above



named, on bail furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M., Bhagalpur in connection Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 242 of 2016, subject to the condition that he will extend full co-operation in the case and will not, in any manner, influence the witnesses or the evidence.
