Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with
Yogapatti P.S.Case No. 345 of 2016 registered for the offences
punishable under Section 364A of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is not named in the FIR and later on his
name transpires during course of investigation.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
even statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. shows that petitioner
along with other accused persons has taken the minor boy of
informant on his lap and left him at Motihari Railway Station and
apart from that there is no allegation against him and he is in
custody for seven months having no criminal antecedent. It has
further been submitted that co-accused has already been granted
bail by this Court in Cr.Misc.No. 17316 of 2017, vide order dated
12.4.2017.

Heard learned APP also.



Having heard both sides and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and also considering the fact that co-accused has already been granted bail, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran, Bettiah, in connection with Yogapatti P.S. Case No. 345 of 2016, subject to the conditions that :-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
