2 24-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 353 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

The petitioners were apprehended while they were carrying 100 litre each of country made liquor.

Petitioners have stated on oath that they have got no criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 06.02.2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail, **on completion of four months of custody**, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten



Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VI, Danapur, Patna/successor Court in connection with Maner Police Station Case No. 48 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
