4 09-05-2017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Karja P.S.Case No.99 of 2016 registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 452, 427, 307, 380 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assault to the injured Nawal Kishore Pandit and there are other allegations also against the other accused persons.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that only allegation is alleged against the petitioner of assault by '*Phatta*' on the head of Nawal Kishore Pandit and the injuries are found to be simple in nature. He is in custody for about 7 ½ months.

Heard learned A.P.P. also, who has not controverted the



aforesaid submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Amit Kumar, J.M. 1st Class, Muzaffarpur in connection with Karja P.S.Case No.99 of 2016

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
