2 10-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted under
Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a)
and 37(b) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The allegation against the petitioner is that 9 litres of
Nepali liquor is said to have been recovered from the possession
of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 16.11.2016. The petitioner has got
no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that 9 litres
of Nepali wine is said to have been recovered from the possession



of the petitioner. There is no compliance of section 100 of the Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Sikrahana, Dhaka, East Champaran, in connection with Dhaka P.S. Case No. 331 of 2016.
