ORAL ORDER

4 18-03-2017 The petitioner is in custody since 24.11.2016 in connection with Revilganj P.S. Case No. 189 of 2016, registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504, 34 and 302 of Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is general and omnibus allegation has been levelled against this petitioner. Further later on it has been alleged that petitioner has assaulted by Salai Wrench and he has been in custody since 24.11.2016.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that two injuries were found on the deceased and that too on the head and it is alleged that petitioner and other co-accused have assaulted the deceased.



Having heard both sides, in view of the fact that there is direct allegation of assault against the petitioner that has been supported by the postmortem report, as such, I am not inclined to grant the petitioner the privilege of regular bail, it is accordingly rejected.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and try to conclude it within a period of six months and if the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail in the court below itself, which will be considered by the court below on the merit of the case, without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
