50 of 2017, registered under Section 30(a) of Bihar Excise
(Amendment) Act, 2016.

The accusation is that the petitioners were
apprehended with 20 bottles, each containing, 300 ML Nepali
wine.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they are in custody
since 12.03.2017.
