ORAL ORDER

03 19.07.2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

Again, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail on the ground mentioned by me in my previous order dated 20.9.2016 passed in Cr. Misc. no 27797/2016 and accordingly, his prayer for bail in connection with Sessions trial no. 771/2016 arising out of Khusrupur P.S. Case no. 84/2015 pending in the court of Addl. Sessions Judge VII, Patnacity stands rejected.

However, learned District Judge, Patna is directed to conclude confidential matter in which original record of Sessions trial no. 771/2016 arising out of Khusrupur P.S. Case no. 84/2015 was called for vide letter no. 83 dated 12.4.2017 within one week from the date of receipt/production of the this order and after return of the record, trial court should expedite the trial of the petitioner even by bifurcating his case from other accused and try to conclude the same



within six months from the date of framing of the charge. However, it is made clear that if trial of the petitioner is not concluded within the above sated period, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail before the learned trial court itself.
