ORAL JUDGMENT

Date: 23-02-2017

This court on 16.08.2010 directed the State to release the arrears of salary payable to the petitioner and other similarly situated persons who are teachers of Ganga Devi Mahila College, a forth phase constituent college.

In the Show cause, it has been pointed out that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has appointed Hon'ble Mr. Justice S. B. Sinha as a one-man Commission to enquire into the various issues mentioned in the order dated 22.01.2013 which also includes the



issue of payment of arrears of salary to the members of the teaching faculty of the forth phase constituent college.

Since the matter is pending before the one-man Commission constituted by the Hon’ble Supreme Court, no further directions are called for in the present contempt application.

Thus, the contempt application stands disposed of.
