Petitioners are in custody in connection with Rajapakar
P.S. Case No. 61 of 2015 registered under Sections 420, 406 and
120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the
petitioners are innocent and has not committed any offence. Charges
have been framed in this case and the petitioners are still rotting in
custody. Moreover, co-accused, Upendra Singh, having more or less
similar allegations, has been granted bail by this Court in Cr. Misc. No.
