for an enquiry into the misappropriation of public money by the
Panchayat Secretary and the *Mukhiya* of *Chhabilapur Gram*
Panchayat in the district of Nalanda.

In the show cause, the stand is that enquiry was
conducted on 12th June, 2012 and in pursuance thereof, first



information report has been lodged. Thus, it cannot be said that the order passed by this Court has not been complied with.

The Contempt Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
