ORAL ORDER

2 16-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

This is an application for bail in connection with
Sursand P.S.Case No. 59 of 2017 registered for the offences
punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioners is of recovery of 10
litres of Nepali wine.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they have falsely been
implicated in this case and they are in custody for more than two
months.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and considering the aforesaid
facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, named above, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Pupri, Sitamarhi, in connection with Sursand P.S.Case No. 59 of 2017, subject to the conditions that :-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make themselves available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on their part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail.
