2 21-03-2017 The order of the Tribunal does not require to be interfered with in the given facts with regard to the status of the present brother claiming dependency upon the deceased brother who was a railway employee.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the circular No. RBE 66 of 1997 looking at the period when the appointment and death occurred of an employee, the necessary documentary evidence not being in place, there should have been deputation of a Welfare Inspector to enquire into the factual



position and circumstance.

Though the writ application is dismissed, but if the petitioner files an application for deputation of a Welfare Inspector for the said enquiry, the same will be considered in accordance with the said circular and objective behind the said circular within a reasonable time frame preferably within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.
