A.P.P. representing the State.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer of bail which was earlier twice rejected vide Criminal Misc. Nos. 48102 of 2015 and 34117 of 2016 by order dated 01.12.2015 and 14.09.2016, respectively, by this Court on the ground that the petitioner is suffering in custody since 04.01.2015, there is no allegation that the petitioner repeated the blow. No offence under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code is made out and it can be a case under Section 304(11) IPC and, as such, the petitioner deserves sympathetic consideration. Up till now charges have not been framed and in near future, trial is not likely to be concluded.

The learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer of bail by



submitting that petitioner is the assailant.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, finding no good ground for reconsideration of prayer of bail, again prayer of bail of the petitioner stands rejected.

However, considering the detention of the petitioner, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within four months, failing which the petitioner may be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
