4 01-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 28.04.2017 in connection with Cheriya Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 201 of 2016 for the offences alleged under Sections 188 and 290 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 47(a) and 54 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in connection with the alleged recovery of 40 packets containing 180 ml. of Officer Choice Prestige Whisky and 7 pockets containing 180 ml. Mc. Dowell Celebration. Recovery of the offending goods from the possession of the petitioner is denied. The petitioner claims clean antecedents.

4. Be that as it may, having regard to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody since 28.04.2017 already suffered, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Manjhaul, Begusarai in connection with Cheriya Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 201 of 2016.
