State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with

Chanan P.S. Case No. 18 of 2017 for the offences under Sections

147,148,149,341,323, 325, 307, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal

Code.

It appears from Annexure-2 that there is a

counter case lodged by co-accused Kedar Mahto.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to

Annexure-3 to submit that the nature of the injury is simple.

Having regard to the statements made in paragraph 3

that there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner and the

fact that there is case and counter case and both sides have



sustained injuries, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM-I, Lakhisarai or the successor Court in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 18 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner will extend full cooperation in conclusion of the trial and will not, in any manner, influence the witnesses.
