Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sheohar
P.S. Case No. 84 of 2017 registered under Sections- 30(A) of
the Bihar Excise Amendment Act 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no concern with the toddy in question. For
recovery of 30-35 liters toddy, petitioner is in custody since
