4 10-07-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Islampur P.S. Case No. 342 of 2016, registered for offences

punishable under Section 25(1-b)/26 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of one
loaded pistol along with ten cartridges.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he
has falsely been implicated in this case. Moreover, he has
sufficiently been punished for the said offence as he has been in
judicial custody since 26.12.2016 and is ready to abide by any
condition imposed on him.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the fact as stated
above, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand)
with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of



learned ACJM, Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with Islampur P.S.

Case No. 342 of 2016, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.

It is also made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of such offence, in future, his bail bonds will be cancelled.
