Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 30(A), 33, 36 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is that 600 ml of Nepali wine was recovered from the open room of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 24.5.2017. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that 600 ml of Nepali wine is said to have been recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the



petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge 1st-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sheohar in connection with Purnahiya P.S. case No.28 of 2017.
