Petitioner has filed this Public Interest Litigation challenging the process of tender awarded by the State Health Society, Bihar, Patna for the purpose of outsourcing of Centralized Call Centre and Operation and Management of Fleet of Ambulances in the State



of Bihar.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are not inclined to go into the matter of the tender process initiated by the State Government for the said purpose. A person aggrieved in the matter of processing of tender and who is interested in participating in the process of tender may have a right to seek indulgence by filing a petition as an aggrieved person but in Public Interest Litigation at the instance of a person like the petitioner, we are not inclined to go into various issues involved in the matter.

The writ petition is, therefore, dismissed with liberty to actually aggrieved persons to ventilate the grievance.
