2 13-07-2017 This application is for grant of bail in connection with

Bangengola P.S. Case No. 98 of 2016 registered for the offence(s)

under section(s) 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR and later on, it
appears that he has been made accused on the basis of
confessional statement.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the
petitioner and he was not put on TIP and he is in custody since
10.3.2017.

Heard learned Additional Public Prosecutor also.
Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for
bail of the petitioner stating that he is an accused in seven other



cases and all the cases are serious in nature.

Having heard both sides and in view of the confessional statement of co-accused as well as the criminal antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant bail to him. However, the Court below is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of six months from the date of receipt or production of a copy of this order. If the trial is not concluded by the aforesaid period, the petitioner will have liberty to renew his prayer for bail.

With the above observation and direction, this application is dismissed.
