Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in Kahalgaon
P.S. Case No.428 of 2016 registered for the offence under
Section 414 of the I.P.C. and Sections 25(1-b) A/26/35 of
Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is that one
pistol and loaded magazine were recovered from his
possession. He is also accused in three more cases.

Submission of the learned counsel for the
petitioner is that he has been falsely implicated in this



case, He is aged about 40 years and in custody for more than 9 months.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Bhagalpur, in Kahalgaon P.S. Case No.428 of 2016 subject to the conditions that (1) one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court. (2) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence. (3) The petitioner shall co-operate in disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court. In the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing



any genuine reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled.
