2 25-08-2017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
P.S.Cae No.80 of 2017 , registered for offences punishable under
Sections 8(C), 20(b)(ii)(B) of N.D.P.S. Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of 14
pouches of '*Ganja*' having 700 grams.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in
custody for two months. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
It is also submitted that from the person form whom more than 01
kg. Ganja has been recovered has already been granted bail by this
Court, vide order dated 30.6.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No.19233 of
2017.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Araria District-Araria in connection with Narpatganj P.S.Case No.80 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court. In the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
