2 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case instituted under
Sections 498(A), 304(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioners is of committing
murder of the deceased due to non-fulfillment of the demand of
dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
the petitioners are in custody since 31.03.2016. The charge sheet
has been submitted in the present case. The petitioners have got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners are the



brother-in-law of the deceased. They are separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased. The husband of the deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the state, it has been submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VI, Bhagalpur, in connection with Kahalgaon (Shiv Narayanpur) P.S. Case No. 93 of 2016 & S.T. No. 525/2016.
