The petitioner seeks bail in Patahi P.S. Case No. 144
of 2016 registered under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner and others are said to have looted the
motorcycle of the informant and cash and mobile of his son-in-
law.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. Nothing incriminating
article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession
of the petitioner. He was not put on test identification parade. The
allegation leveled against the petitioner is not specific rather
omnibus. The petitioner has been languishing in custody since



31.01.2017.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VIII, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 144 of 2016
