Heard learned counsel for the petitioner

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Barhariya PS case no. 07 of 2017 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 20/22 of N.D.P.S. Act.

The case of the prosecution is that on 09.01.2017,
the police had received secret information and thereafter, the
informant along with other police officials had conducted raid at
the place of occurrence at about 6 am in the morning and
apprehended the petitioner herein as well as other co-accused
persons and from their possession, *charas* was seized. Apart from
charas, firearms and stolen vehicle was also recovered from the
possession of accused persons.



The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that small quantity of *charas* has been recovered and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case.

Having gone through the materials on record, I find that the petitioner is a habitual offender and as many as eight cases are pending as against the petitioner herein. On this ground alone, the present petition is fit to be dismissed. Nonetheless, considering the accusation leveled against the petitioner, I do not consider it just and appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for grant of regular bail on behalf of petitioner is dismissed.
