2 21-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 30 (a) and 62 of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, about 115 liters of foreign liquor were recovered from the house of co-accused Rakesh Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. It is urged that the petitioners are in custody since 30.07.2017. It is claimed that their antecedent is clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above-named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction



of Special Judge-cum-Additional Sessions Judge-7, Begusarai
in connection with Begusarai Town P.S. Case No. 389/2017
with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this
case, are again found involved in similar nature of cases then the
concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation
of their bail bonds.
