Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for
offences under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code
and Sections 30 (a), 38 and 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that as per allegation, 9 litres of
foreign liquor were recovered from the motorcycle which was
being boarded by the petitioners. Petitioners claim that they are
having clean antecedent and are in custody since 05.06.2017.



Considering the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioners, abovenamed are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Pupri P.S. Case No. 146 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
