learned A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in connection with Sono P.S.
Case No. 105 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under
Sections 30(a), 41 and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

The prosecution case, as lodged by the police
personnel, is that during course of checking of vehicles, one Indica
car was intercepted and the petitioners along with driver, Sanoj
Kumar were apprehended and from the bag kept inside the car,
206 liters of country made wine was recovered.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the



petitioners that they are innocent, bear no criminal history and have been falsely implicated in the aforesaid case. He submits that the petitioners are casual labourers at Deoghar and on the way to their village have boarded the vehicle and have no concern with the seized articles. He further submits that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners, they are neither the driver nor the owner of the car and that charge-sheet has already been submitted, hence, there is no chance of tampering with the prosecution evidence.

However, learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances and the materials on record, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate 1st, Jamui in connection with Sono P.S. Case No. 105 of 2017.
